# How Prepared Are You For Disaster? Let's Start Learning From Today

## Be Aware of the Disaster Risk of Your Home

What kind of area do you live in? How many meters above sea level is it? Is there a steep slope nearby creating a risk of landslides? What is the possibility of flooding? Etc. It is very important to be aware of the disaster risk of the place that you are living in. Check the Disaster Prevention Map of Ginowan City to check your disaster risk.

You can pick up the Disaster Prevention Map of Ginowan City (Japanese version) from the City office.

#### **Know Your Evacuation Route**

Find out the location of the tsunami evacuation building in your neighborhood. Get familiar with the evacuation route by walking to the building and check how safe the route is. Are there any buildings or structures along the way that are likely to collapse? How many minutes does it take to reach the evacuation site? When a tsunami warning is issued, check the expected time when the wave is expected to reach land and its height. Take appropriate measures depending on the situation.

### Find Out the Location of Tsunami Evacuation Sites in Your Neighborhood

When the tsunami warning was issued on April 3, there was about an hour between the warning and the expected time for the wave to reach the land. But this might not be the case every time. There might be times when tsunami can reach land within minutes. In such cases, it is important to evacuate at the earliest. Go immediately to the top of the tsunami evacuation building to reach higher ground as soon as possible. Be sure to know the location of at least three tsunami evacuation sites closest to you. You can pick up the List of Tsunami Evacuation Buildings in Ginowan City (Japanese version) from the City office.

#### **Prepare Your Emergency Evacuation Kit**

Keep an emergency kit ready so that you can evacuate quickly in the event of a disaster. Include things such as drinking water, food, batteries and chargers, medicine for chronic illnesses, etc. Pack enough for at least three days. Check the list of things to keep in an emergency evacuation

You can pick up the List of Things to Pack in Emergency Kit (Japanese version) from the City office.

#### ► Who needs to apply (Government officials should contact their employer)

- Residents who are ineligible for special benefit as their income exceeds the upper income limit
- 2 Residents who are raising children of high school age, but not raising children of junior high school.
- 3 Residents who have children between age 18 22 (age at the end of fiscal year) are now eligible for Multiple Child Allowance.
- 4 Welfare facilities who have newly admitted children in their facilities.
- Welfare facilities that are already eligible for child benefit and have high school-age children among the children under their care.
- ► Application Deadline: Friday, October 11, 2024

Applications received by this deadline will receive payments in December 2024. There is a grace period to apply for the revised child benefit plan under which applications will be accepted up to March 31, 2025, and back payments will be made up to October 2024.

First payment of the new child benefit plan will be made on December 10, 2024 (Tuesday)
