

# Ginowan City COVID-19 Vaccination Schedule

Those who have already received their vaccines (such as health workers) can dispose of their vouchers.

Priority will be given to those who have preexisting medical conditions. Please refrain from making a booking before it is your turn to do so.

In some cases, those who have received their vouchers and who wish to be vaccinated through the Okinawa Prefectural Mass Vaccination Centre are allowed to make a booking before the dates outlined above. For details, please contact the Okinawa Prefectural Mass Vaccination Call Centre.

The dates listed above are tentative and may change depending on vaccine supply. Updates can be found on the Ginowan City website (scan the QR code on your vaccination voucher envelop).

## Order of Vaccination

### ① Seniors

Residents who will be 65 years of age or above in 2021.

### ② People with preexisting medical conditions

1. Individuals under the age of 65 who are hospitalized or are receiving outpatient care due to the following medical conditions.

- Chronic respiratory disease
- Chronic heart disease (including hypertension)
- Chronic kidney disease
- Chronic liver disease (excluding fatty liver and chronic hepatitis)
- Diabetes being treated with insulin or medication or diabetes associated with other diseases
- Blood diseases (excluding iron deficiency anemia)
- Diseases that impair the functioning of the immune system (including malignant tumours under treatment)
- Receiving treatment that depresses the immune system, including steroids
- Neurological and neuromuscular diseases associated with immune abnormalities
- Impaired physical function due to neurological or neuromuscular diseases (respiratory disorders, etc.)
- Chromosomal abnormality
- Severe mental and physical disabilities (severe physical disabilities and severe intellectual disabilities)
- Sleep apnea syndrome
- Serious mental illness (currently hospitalized for treatment of mental illness, is in possession of a mental disability certificate, is classified as "severe" or "continuing support" under the Services and Supports for Persons with Disabilities program), or has intellectual disability (in possession of a Rehabilitation Certificate)

2. Obese individuals who has a BMI of 30 or higher

③ **Employees of nursing homes or other welfare facilities who regularly come into contact with the elderly (which may include designated in-home service providers and home visit nursing care providers as determined by the city)**

### ④ Others (people between 12 to 64 years of age)

Vouchers for children who will turn 12 years old this year will be mailed out on the month of their birthday.

## Getting vaccinated outside of the municipality where you are registered

You must receive your vaccine in the municipality in which you are registered. However, you may be approved to receive your vaccine in another city if you fulfill certain requirements (see below).

If you move out of Ginowan City, please use the vaccination voucher issued to you by your new municipality.

<The following individuals must notify the city in which they wish to receive the vaccine in advance>

- Employees posted away from their families
- Students residing outside of their permanent residence, etc.

<The following individuals do not need to notify the city of their choice ahead of time>

- Hospitalized individuals or those living in a facility
- Those with preexisting medical conditions who are receiving the vaccine from their primary doctor
- Those receiving the vaccine in national or prefectural vaccination centres
- Those receiving workplace vaccinations, etc.

Even if you don't fulfill any of the conditions above, you may still be able to receive your vaccine outside of Ginowan City. Please confirm with the municipality in which you wish to receive the vaccine, or visit the CoronaVaccineNavi for more information.

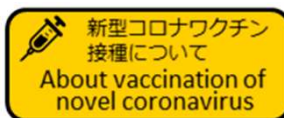

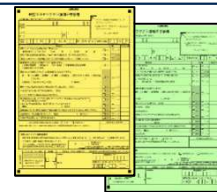
# Inoculation flowchart

## Before your appointment

Complete the medical questionnaire in advance: yellow for the 1<sup>st</sup> dose, green for the 2<sup>nd</sup> dose.

People under the age of 16 must have their parent guardian sign their medical questionnaire prior to arriving at the venue.

On the day of your appointment, a staff will attach a sticker in the rectangular space on the upper right corner of the form.



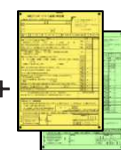
## Inoculation flowchart

### Things to bring

### Temperature check

If your temperature is over 37.5°C and you are displaying cold symptoms (or a fever), you may be refused a vaccine.

If you are taking anticoagulants (blood-thinners), apply pressure on the injection site for at least two minutes.



Wear clothes that make it easy to access your shoulders.

You will be given a vaccination certificate and an explanation regarding the 2<sup>nd</sup> dose of the vaccine.

Pfizer (age 12 and above)

2<sup>nd</sup> dose should be administered after 3 weeks

Moderna (age 18 and above)

2<sup>nd</sup> dose should be administered after 4 weeks

### Health monitoring

Remain at the site for 15 to 30 minutes in case you should experience an unusual reaction.

## After inoculation

Refrain from doing intense exercise or drinking in large quantities.

Keep the injection site clean. When taking a shower, refrain from scrubbing the injection site excessively.

Common side effects include pain around the injection site, fatigue and a light fever. These side effects should subside in 2 to 3 days.

## Your consent is required to receive the vaccine

The COVID-19 vaccine that will be administered is a mRNA vaccine. With any type of vaccine, there is a risk of adverse side effects causing need for treatment or permanent damage.

In order to receive the vaccine, you must give consent on your own volition after having fully understood the potential benefits of getting vaccinated (efficacy) and the risks, including the possibility of adverse side effects, that may be involved (safety).

Please refrain from directly or indirectly coercing your colleagues and others around you to receive the vaccine.

If you are currently recovering from a medical condition or if you have concerns about receiving a vaccine due to your health condition, please consult with your primary physician before deciding whether to get vaccinated.
