#### What does LGBT mean?

In this current day and age, "LGBT" is a word frequently used on TV and other media. LGBT is an initialism made out of the first letter of the 4 main sexual and gender identities:

- L: Lesbian (women attracted to women)
- G: Gay (men attracted to men)
- **B**: Bisexual (individual attracted to both genders)
- T: Transgender (Individual with a gender identity that differs from their assigned sex. Also includes individuals with Gender Dysphoria)

However the LGBT Community is welcoming, and includes many other kinds of identities (and thus additional letters), such as "Q", standing for "Questioning" (individual who is still exploring their gender identity) or "Queer" (individual with an identity outside of the established ideas of gender and sexuality).

Everyone has their own definition of "gender": "gender" is a concept much more complex and diverse than one can imagine!

To think that LGBT is "different", or is "from a different world" may be hurtful to the people around you. It is important to stay conscious of our words and actions, and remember to respect everybody's gender identity.

#### Let's put things into perspective...

It is said that 7, 6% of the Japanese population is part of the LGBT community.

- ⇒1 out of 13 is part of the LGBT community
- ⇒1 out of 11 is left-handed
- ⇒1 out of 10 has the AB Blood type (source: 2015 年電通ダイバーシティ・ラボ)

#### Challenges faced by LGBT People

- ⇒School bathrooms. PE changing rooms, swimsuits
- ⇒Being attracted to a different gender than their friends
- ⇒Conflict between their body's physical changes and how they feel inside
- ⇒Discrimination when looking for a job
- ⇒Same-sex marriage issue

The Tokyo 2020 Olympic and Paralympic Games Organizing Committee has decided to use recycled metals from old electronic devices to produce the medals for the Games. Ginowan is one of the many cities participating in this project. We encourage everyone to contribute to the initiative! Let's create a sustainable society together!

#### WHAT:

cellphones, smartphones, digital cameras, laptops, audio players, calculators, tablets, electronic dictionaries, digital voice recorders, handheld game consoles

% the device must fit into the opening of the collection box (4.5 cm x 42 cm).

#### WHERE:

There will be a collection box.

⇒Lobby of the Ginowan City Hall (front entrance), next to the reception desk

#### WHEN:

- ⇒December 25<sup>th</sup>~Spring 2019
- →8:30~17:00
- (Weekends and Holidays excluded)

The collected items will then be handed over to certified operators of the Tokyo Olympic and Paralympic Games Organizing Committee, and transformed into medals. The certified operators are receiving national approval regarding the handling measures to prevent any issues like the leaking of private information from the devices.

#### WHAT TO KEEP IN MIND:

- ⇒The object must be a home device (devices from companies are not eligible)
- ⇒Please erase all personal data and turn off the device
- ⇒Once inserted in the collection box, it will not be possible to get the device back
