Reinforcement of Prefectural-Municipal Tax Collection in November and December

In order to strengthen tax collection at the prefectural tax office and all municipalities within the prefecture, intensive recovery methods of delinquent tax such as seizure of savings, salary, real estate, vehicle (by using wheel locks) and seizure through investigation of property are being implemented. Please pay your taxes by the deadlinel

✓ Cash seizures: 236 cases ✓ Real estate seizures: 10 cases ✓ Investigation of property: 17 cases

Health and Welfare News

Flu Shot Season is here!

Part of the cost for influenza vaccination is subsidized for people over 65 years old. Eligible people have received a notice in the mail.

Eligible people: Ginowan residents over 65 years old Vaccination period: Until February 28th, 2019 Vaccination site: designated medical facilities

Cost: 1,000 yen

(free of charge for people on public assistance)
People between 60 and 64 years old with a severe impairment (to the heart, etc.) may be eligible for this subsidy. Please consult your primary care doctor.

Preventive measures against the flu:

① Hand washing and gargling / ② Respecting coughing etiquette /③Getting plenty of sleep (and rest) and eating a balanced, nutritious diet / ④ Maintaining proper body temperature /⑤Avoiding large crowds and wearing a mask when going outside /⑥Taking the flu shot

Do you need help applying for a My Number card?

Starting November 1st, the citizen division at the city hall offers assistance and free ID photo services for the My Number card application procedure. Feel free to come by if you are having difficulties applying or if you cannot have a photograph ready for your application.



Reception Hours and Location

*The process may take about 30 minutes. No reservation is required. Please leave time to spare as there are a limited number of computer terminals. Waiting time may vary depending on the crowd.

What to bring:

- ① Piece of identification (driver's license, passport, health insurance card...)
- ② My Number notification card and application form for the issuance of the My Number Card/electronic certificate *you can apply for re-issuance if you have misplaced it.

Services offered:

- ① ID photograph (the picture will be deleted after the application process)
- 2 Online application

Applications will be filed through a terminal with the picture taken at the window counter. The staff will file the application and handle the difficult operations for you. About one month to one month and half after applying, you will be mailed a postcard notifying you that your card is ready for pick-up. Make sure to bring all required documents when going to the city hall to pick up your card. Please be aware that the photo taken with the computer terminal does not have the best image quality. You will have to re-apply if there are any deficiencies in your application.
