National Health Insurance & Medical Care System for People Aged 75 and Over: Payments start in July!

The 2019 National Health Insurance premiums are paid in 8 monthly installments until February next year, and the premiums for Medical Care System for People Aged 75 and Over are paid in 9 monthly installments until March next year. You can pay the bills at designated financial facilities or at any convenience stores within Japan. Please pay as soon as you can: if you fail to pay by the deadline, you may be subject to late fees. Please contact the National Health Insurance Division if you need any help.

Long-term Care Insurance (Kaigo Hoken), a System Supported by Society as a Whole

Long-term Care insurance bills will be mailed to people aged 65 and over at the beginning of July
The Long-term Care insurance system is financed by the premium contributions of citizens over 40 years old and public funds from the city, the prefecture and the country. In accordance with the



determined long-term care insurance premium amount for this year, the bills for this year's long-term care insurance will be mailed to

those aged 65 and over at the beginning of July.

Payment methods

■ Special Collection (deducted from pension)

This is for people whose yearly amount of pension is over 180,000 yen. The long-term care insurance premiums will be deducted beforehand from the old-age basic pension annuity, disability basic pension annuity, basic pension for the bereaved, etc.

■Normal Collection (automatic withdrawal or bills)

The yearly premium amount notice as well as the bills, separated into 8 installments (from July 2019 to February 2020), will be mailed to you. To those with automatic withdrawal, only the notice is sent to you.

Keep your receipts! Long-term insurance premiums may be eligible for social insurance premium deduction during the filing of income tax return.

Please contact the Long-Term Care Division if you are having trouble paying your long-term insurance premiums. You may be eligible for collection reduction or postponement.

Did you receive your coupons for the rubella antibody testing/vaccination?

Males born between April 2nd 1962 and April 1st 1977 who have not received the public vaccine have a lower antibody prevalence rate than other generations (about 80%). People with insufficient amount of antibodies (according to the results of the antibody testing) may get the vaccination as a routine vaccination.

Take this opportunity to get tested/vaccinated! **Eligibility:** Males born between April 2nd 1962 and April 1st 1977

Period: Until March 31st 2022 (3 years)

Fee: Free of charge

Vaccination site: Participating medical facilities within the prefecture/iapan

Due Date for Resident Tax (1st Payment): Monday, July 1st

Please make sure to pay by the deadline. People who refuse to pay their city tax arrears despite having the means to do so may be subject to a lawful investigation and have their property seized (savings, salary, home, car...) etc.

Tax payment via bank transfer is a convenient option if you worry about forgetting payment deadlines. Please contact us if interested.

National Pension Payment Exemption System for FY2019: Application starts in July

Full monthly contribution for national pension of FY 2019: 16,410 yen

If your income (along with the household spouse's income) of the previous year (or the income from 2 years before if applying between January and June) is lower than the determined amount and you are having trouble paying the

national pension premiums, you may be granted payment exemption if you apply and submit the exemption form.

There are 4 kinds of exemption: full exemption, 3/4 exemption, half exemption and 1/4 exemption.

- ■Exemption can be applied retroactively for up to 2 years and 1 month from the month of application.
- ■Other kinds of exemptions include the Contribution Postponement System and the Special Payment System for Students.
- The Japan Pension Service will examine your income upon application. Your type of eligibility will depend on your income.

If approved, your exempted contributions will...

① Be counted towards the contribution period (up to 10 years) for your future Old-age Pension. However, the applicant will receive a lower amount of pension than if they had made full contributions (payment exemption under the Contribution Postponement System and the Special Payment System for Students will not be reflected in the pension amount).

② Be treated as payment if you become entitled for the Survivor's Pension or Disability Pension.

**However, failure to pay the partial contributions (1/4, half or 3/4) will be regarded as non-payment, and therefore the above advantages will not apply.
