# Application for School Expense Subsidies 2020

Subsidies for school supplies and school lunch fees are available for families with children enrolled in elementary and junior high (middle) school.

The initial round of application ended last August, but a new round is currently open for families that have not yet applied. Application form and related documents are available at each public elementary and middle school, or at the Board of Education office (on the second floor of the building beside the Fire Department Headquarters).

Application Period: February 3<sup>rd</sup> (Mon) – April 10<sup>th</sup> (Fri) \*If granted, disbursement will commence in May.

Where to submit your application:

- Public schools : submit to your school directly
- National, prefectural, and private schools : submit to the Board of Education office

Eligibility: Children born between April 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2005 – April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2014 (Enrolled between Grade 1 to Grade 9 as of 2020)

Non-Registered Day Care Facility Subsidies for Single Parent Families

Subsidies are available for single parent families whose child or children are enrolled in non-registered day care facilities due to unique circumstances such as a lack of space in public (registered) day care, etcetera. Subsidies include an upper limit of ¥33,000 for the cost of enrolment and ¥5000 for meal expenses. Certain conditions must be met. Please visit our office for any inquiries or to apply.

As a general rule, disbursement begins the following month after which the application has been submitted.

# Did you know... Pension contributions begin at age 20!



#### What is the National Pension System?

National Pension is a public pension system participated by all persons living in Japan and which provides benefits to the elderly or those affected by disability or death to support their day-to-day life. Every registered resident in Japan above age 20 and under 60

are required to enroll. Premiums must be paid every month.

#### How much does it cost?

The monthly premium for the 2019 fiscal year is ¥16,410.
