## Apply for the Grant for School-Related Expense

Grant covers school-related expenses such as school lunches for elementary and junior high students

Children born **between April 2, 2007 and April 1, 2016** who are or will be attending elementary or junior high school in Ginowan City in the 2022 school year are eligible to apply. This includes children who will enter grade one in April 2022. <u>Applications must be renewed every year.</u>

Application forms can be picked up **between 7/19 (Mon) and 8/31 (Tue)** at your school's office or at the Ginowan City Board of Education.

Bring your completed forms to the Ginowan City Multipurpose Conference Room on the following dates:

- 1. Futenma & Mashiki Jr. High district ----- 8/16 (Mon) 8/20 (Fri)
- 2. Kakazu & Ginowan Jr. High district ------ 8/23 (Mon) 8/27 (Fri)
- 3. Others ----- 8-30 (Mon) 8/31 (Tue)

Your household income\* will be assessed to determine your eligibility. Refer to the chart on the right.

# Renewing your high-cost medical expense coverage

For people under the age of 75 who already have an Eligibility Certificate for Ceiling-Amount Application and Reduction of the Standard Amount of Patient Liability

Your current Eligibility Certificate expires on July 31st. If you wish to continue receiving the high-cost medical expense coverage, please visit the National Health Insurance Division at the city office between 8:30 a.m. and 5:15 p.m. on weekdays to renew

your eligibility.

Please bring the following items on your visit:

- Health insurance card
- ID
- Name seal (inkan) only if you have one

If you are applying on behalf of someone else in your household, you must provide an authorization form completed and signed by the person whom you are representing.
