ALL YOU NEED TO KNOW ABOUT NATIONAL PENSION

To receive pension, you must contribute or complete the appropriate paperwork in advance

■ What is National Pension?

The National Pension System was created with the intention that society as a whole can provide for citizens in their old age, when they are affected by a disability resulting from an illness or injury, or when the breadwinner of the family passes away. Aside from the Old-Age Basic Pension, there is also the Disability Basic Pension and Survivors' Basic Pension for unforeseen. However, failure to complete the appropriate paperwork and leaving premiums unpaid may result in the disqualification to receive pension payments.

Every resident of Japan between 20 and 59 years of age irrespective of nationality must be an insured person under the National Pension System.

▶ Category I Insured Persons

- students, self-employed and unemployed persons, etc.

▶ Category II Insured Persons

- company employees, government employees (those enrolled in the Employees' Pension System), etc.

▶ Category III Insured Persons

- Dependent spouses of a Category II Insured Person

■ How do I enroll in National Pension?

The Japan Pension Service will notify those who turned 20 years of age to enroll in National Pension as a Category I Insured Person. To enroll as a Category II or III Insured Person, please speak with your employer.

■ How much are the premiums?

The monthly premium for Category I Insured Persons for fiscal year 2023 is 16,520 yen.

■ What if I can't make payment?

If you are having difficulty making contributions, you can apply for an exemption. In order to be approved for an exemption, your income from the previous year must be below a certain amount.

1. Special Payment Plan for Students
2. Application for Contribution Exemption/Payment Postponement (for non-students)

■ When can I receive pension payments?

If you have been enrolled in the pension system and have made contributions, you can receive payments in the following scenario:

1. When you turn 65 (Old-Age Basic Pension)
2. When you become disabled due to an injury or illness (Disability Basic Pension)
 - Conditions such as the level of disability apply
3. When your spouse or parent dies (Survivors' Basic Pension)
 - Conditions such as having shared the same livelihood may apply
