02.02 (Fri) from 14:30 (doors open 14:00) at each junior high school *To be attended by guardians and students.


There is no parking at the schools. Please come using public transport.

Apply to be waitlisted for a slot at a public afterschool children's club for the 2024 school year

FOR THOSE WHO MISSED THE APPLICATION PERIOD FOR APRIL 1 ENROLLMENT



Any child who resides in the city, is enrolled in an elementary school, and who requires after-school supervision due to having working parents or is suffering from an illness is eligible to apply. All applications will be assessed based on the perceived need for childcare services determined by the guardians' employment status, conditions of the household, etc.

The after-school children's club provides supervision for children after they finish school until 18:00. During summer, winter and spring break, supervision is available from 8:30 to 18:00. As a general rule, parents are expected pick up their children on weekdays, and send as well as pick up their children during the aforementioned holiday period. The children's clubs are closed every 2nd and 4th Saturday, Sundays, holidays, Okinawa Memorial Day, and other days approved by the mayor. The monthly fee is 5,000 yen per child.

Application forms are available for pickup from Jan. 10 (Wed) at each Children's Centre every weekday 10:00-12:00 and 13:00-18:00. Submit your forms to your preferred Children's Centre in person on any weekday between the hours 10:00-11:30, and 13:30-17:30. You will be notified by phone if there is an opening.
