FY2023 Ginowan City Financial Aid for Resident Tax-Exempt Households

In light of soaring food and energy prices, Ginowan City is offering resident tax-exempt households, who are particularly affected by rising costs, a financial aid of 70,000 yen per household.

1. Eligibility

Households that fulfill all of the following criteria are eligible for this aid.

- ① Was registered on the city's Basic Resident Register (or had a Certificate of Residence with Ginowan City) as of December 1, 2023
- ② All the members of household are exempt from the fiscal year 2023 per capita levy of resident tax
- ③ Is not a household that comprises only of dependents of an individual who is taxable for resident tax

2. Aid amount

70,000 yen per household (one-time only) *Check your bank book for the deposit.

3. Application deadline

February 29, 2024 (Thursday) (must be postmarked by this date)

*You will be considered to have forfeited your application if you miss the submission deadline.

4. How to submit an application

Please check the contents of the confirmation form on the right (such as bank details) and confirm your eligibility before mailing it back to the Ginowan City Office using the return envelope provided. You may also choose to complete the application online.

〈Online application〉

If the bank details printed on the top of the confirmation form are correct and you do not wish to have the aid deposited into a different bank account, you can choose to complete the application online. Scan the QR code on the right to access the application webpage. Once you have successfully completed the application online, you do not need to mail the form back to the city office.
